

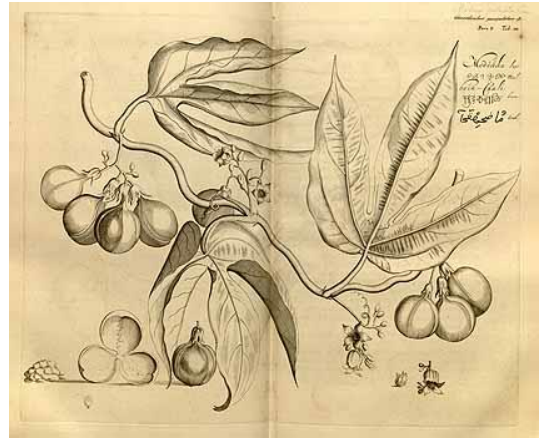
GIFTIGE PLANTE

Acokanthera oppositifolia (Boesmanspylgif)

Acokanthera oppositifolia is a shrub used as the source of an arrow poison and to coat caltrops made from the sharp fruits of the puncture vine. All three plants of the genus *Acokanthera* contain toxic cardiac glycosides strong enough to cause death.
